## **POLICY ON REQUESTING AND CANCELLATION OF REQUEST OF UMPIRES**

### **Requests**

All requests for Umpires must be sent to our administrator, Brian Catt.

Requests should be done electronically via e-mail to [admin@cglcusa.co.za](mailto:admin@cglcusa.co.za).  
Requests may also be done telephonically but then needs to be ratified via e-mail.

Requests need to be submitted within the following time frame:

<b>Description</b>	<b>Period</b>
Umpires requested for a Saturday or Sunday	By the close of business on the Tuesday before the weekend.
6 (six) umpires or less	48 (fourty eight) hours before the relevant match(es)
More than 6 (six) umpires	1 (one) week before the match(es)
Umpires to stand for more than 1 (one) day. i.e. Time cricket matches over a number of days Festivals Tournaments	1 (one) week before the event / match(es)

Request received later than indicated above will be considered, and if possible, umpires will be allocated the relevant match(es).

An additional administration fee of 10% of the total cost of the umpires will be charged.

### **Freelancing**

Umpires may only stand in a match after being allocated to it by the Association.  
All requests for umpires must also be sent to the Association and the umpires may not be contacted directly.

The only exception will be if the umpire standing in the match is an employee of the relevant school, club or organisation and is an active current member of the CGLCUA.  
The Association must be notified of all such exceptions.

## Food and Drinks

Unless a prior arrangement has been agreed on between all parties the following policy will be followed:

- Drinks are to be provided to all the umpires during Drinks Breaks and any other scheduled intervals during the days play.
- Where umpires are required to be at a match(es) for more than 4 hours they are to be provided with lunch or supper.
- The person or entity responsible for the umpire's food and drinks must be disclosed at the initial request for umpires.
- Where these requirements are not met the umpires will be instructed to cater for themselves and to claim these costs from the Association. The Association will then add these costs to total fees charged for the match(es) or event.

## Required Information with each request

- Name of the relevant responsible person.
- Person(s) in charge on the day(s) of play.
- Cellphone and e-mail details of all the people involved.
- Person or entity responsible for umpire's food and drinks.
- Date(s) the umpire(s) are required
- Time(s) of match(es)
- Venue(s) of the match(es)
- Teams involved in the match(es)
- Format of the match(es)
- If applicable, any special playing conditions applicable to the match(es)
- Colour of the ball to be used for the match(es)

## Cancelled matches

Our administrator, Brian Catt, is to be informed of all cancellations or rescheduling via e-mail.

These notices need to be done at least 24 hours before the match(es).

If the CGLCUA has not received these notices in time, the match(es) will still be charged for.

## Calling of matches

Any match(es) called-off on the day due to the conditions of ground, weather or light, or any other reason, where the umpires are already present or have left their homes to attend the match, will be charged for as if the fixture happened without any interruption or cancellation.

## **APPOINTMENT POLICY**

It is our policy to, as far as possible, always appoint 2 (two) qualified umpires to any match.

The appointment of only 1 (one) official umpire to a match will only be considered in selected instances where the reasons for this change in policy is properly motivated and where this will not significantly affect the quality of umpiring in the match.

In the event where is not possible to allocate 2 (two) umpires, or where the allocation of only 1 (one) umpire is approved by the CGLCUA Executive, the following procedures will be enforced:

- The appointed CGLCUA umpire will stand at the bowlers end throughout the game, and
- The other umpire(s) will only perform the square-leg umpire duties.  
(The other umpire(s) in this case may be a coach, a teacher, a parent, the team manager or even one of the players from the batting team)

The appointed CGLCUA umpire will be sole judge of fair and unfair play and he / she solely will decide whether either conditions of ground, weather or light or exceptional circumstances mean that it would be dangerous or unreasonable for play to take place.

Due to the added workload and responsibilities the CGLCUA will charge a seperate rate per umpire for these matches.

The only time the other umpire will be allowed to fulfil the full duties of an umpire is when this person is a current active member of the CGLCUA. In this case the standard rates per umpire will be charged and both umpires will perform the same duties. (An example of this would be if the coach of the team is an active member of the CGLCUA and he / she umpires the match with an appointed CGLCUA umpire.)

## COST OF UMPIRES

The Central Gauteng Lions Cricket Umpires Association is a non-profit organisation and the rates we charge for providing umpires are basically the same amounts we pay to the umpires for their services rendered.

Outside of our CGL League commitments all our other umpires are paid the same amount. We will therefore also charge the same amount for any of these umpires allocated to matches irrelevant of their level of qualification and amount of on field experience.

In a very few limited occasions we will deviate from our standard pricelist, and only then if the occasion seriously justifies this deviation.

Our umpires are paid for the expected time they will be standing.

The annual pricelist is reviewed before every season and then approved by the executive for the duration of that season. These rates will be used for all matches during season irrespective of the level or status of the specific match(es).

The pricelist includes rates per umpire for when we allocate 2 (two) umpires to a match and for when our umpire is the only appointed qualified umpire standing in a match. Due to the added workload and responsibilities when our umpire is standing alone a separate rate will be charged for that particular match(es).
